



How to get here

From Stromness: When departing the ferry in Stromness turn right upon departure from the ferry parking lot onto the A965 taking you towards Kirkwall. Take the 3rd left off the traffic circle and take a right at the end of the road. Turn right at A964 signposted to Orphir. Continue for approximately 5 miles and Buxa Farm Chalets is signposted on the right. Go to the end of the road and take a left at next signpost. Approximately 15 minutes. If using GPS use postcode: KW17 2RD

From Kirkwall: When departing the ferry in Kirkwall turn left upon departure from the ferry parking lot and head through industrial park (taking you towards Kirkwall) to junction, take left and then 2nd left off traffic circle at Mills Filling Station and follow road to another traffic circle and take 2nd left. Take a right at the A964 Orphir road and stay on for about 20 minutes passing through small village of Orphir and uphill past Houton Ferry Terminal. Buxa Farm Chalets is signposted on the left. Go to the end of the road and take a left at next signpost. If using GPS use postcode: KW17 2RD

From St. Margaret's Hope: When departing the ferry from St Margaret's Hope follow signs to Kirkwall. You will pass Highland Park Distillery on the right when entering Kirkwall, follow the road around and then take left at the A964 Orphir road (signposted) and stay on for about 20 minutes passing through small village of Orphir and uphill past Houton Ferry Terminal. Buxa Farm Chalets is signposted on the left. Go to the end of the road and take a left at next signpost. If using GPS use postcode: KW17 2RD



What is there to see and do?


The most common complaint we get from visitors is that there just isn't enough time to see everything in Orkney! We suggest before you visit that you log on to the local tourist information site:

The croft house is situated on 20 acres of waterfront property that is under the Rural Stewardship scheme to preserve bird life. There is a bird hide on the property to observe birds up close on the pond. A children's playpark adjacent to the croft house provides hours of play for young ones. A dedicated walk with gates at top and bottom has been developed giving easy access to the shore without having to climb over barbed wire. Secure storage for bicycles and camping and fishing gear. Putt Putt course and lawn croquet.

Large patio doors from the kitchen lead out to a paved patio area with large picnic table for "al fresco dining" while enjoying the glorious sunsets over Scapa Flow and Stromness.
